

## The Christmas Quiz!

**Lesduur:** 45 minuten | **Lesvorm:** quiz | **Werkwijze:** klassikaal

### Wat heb je nodig?

- Een prijs voor het winnende team (bijv. kerstsnoepjes, klein speelgoed of bureauartikelen met een kerstversiering erop. Je kunt ook denken aan een beloning in de vorm van een dag geen corvee of kiezen wat er in een vrij lesuur wordt gedaan).
- Eventueel blaadje voor elk team.



### Introduction

It is almost Christmas! What do you know about Christmas? Today we are going to play a Christmas Quiz.

### Instruction

- Split the class in five teams. Give each team a number: 1 – 5.
- Choose a name for your team. The name has got to do something with Christmas. For example: *The Christmas Trees.*  
Give the teams a few minutes and then ask for the names. Write the team numbers and their names on the board.
- Explain the rules: *The quiz has 15 questions. Next I am going to start with question 1 and team 1. You get 10 seconds per question to discuss the answer. If a team knows the correct answer, they get 1 point. If they don't know the answer, or the answer is wrong, the question passes to the next team, till a team knows the correct answer. Then this team gets the point. The team with the most points wins a prize. Announce the prize: The winning team gets...*

- Ready? Let's play! Merry... quizmas! Start with question 1. Tell team 1 'Time is up' if they did not answer in 10 seconds. After each correct answer, write down the score on the board.
- Look at the score when all 15 questions are answered. Play the shoot-out question if there are two or more winning teams.
- Announce the winning team and hand out the prizes.
